Curriculum Overview

RI REC’s grant funding allows providers in our EHR Adoption Program to take **free online** courses about Electronic Health Records (EHRs), Health Information Technology (HIT), and Health Information Exchange (HIE). Providers who successfully complete the online curriculum in one or more of the three areas of concentration will receive the nationally recognized Certified Professional in EHRs (CPEHR), Health Information Exchange (CPHIE) and/or Health Information Technology (CPHIT) certification(s).

Each area of concentration includes four core courses:

- Overview of HIT, EHR, and HIE
- Legal and Regulatory Aspects of HIT, EHR, and HIE
- HIT, EHR and HIE Goals and Migration Path
- Change Management for HIT, EHR and HIE
