How will currentcare benefit you and your practice?

Here are 8 ways:

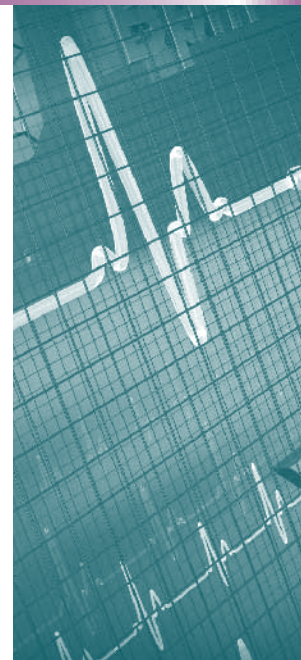
1. currentcare will help your practice succeed under the new payment systems
2. You will be able to easily retrieve accurate reporting and comparison metrics as well as look at how your practice is performing relative to others
3. You will have access to your patients' most up to date health information – all in one place
4. You will be able to access your enrolled patients' medication history
5. Your patients' medical history will be available to them in an emergency situation – when you are not available to be their advocate
6. Your practice will receive \$3.00 per successful enrollment. And that can add up--if you see 50 patients per day and enroll half of them, you could earn up to \$1,500 per month
7. Provider Notification will ensure that your practice will automatically receive a secure email regarding your patient's hospital admission or discharge
8. By enrolling your patients in currentcare, **YOU** will be helping transform and improve Rhode Island's healthcare system

Those practices that enroll the highest percentage of their patients will be among the **FIRST** to have access to currentcare's **PATIENT RECORD INQUIRY SERVICE** and be able to view a patient's longitudinal clinical record.

- 1 in 5 Rhode Islanders are enrolled
- Nearly 400 hospitals, physician offices, long-term facilities, and visiting nurse agencies are enrolling patients
- Lab data is flowing into currentcare from Lifespan Laboratories, East Side Clinical Laboratory, Care New England Laboratories, a private EpiChart practice, and South County Hospital
- Admission/Discharge/Transfer (ADT) feeds are flowing into currentcare from South County Hospital, with feeds soon to come from Kent Hospital, Women & Infants Hospital, Roger Williams Medical Center, and St. Joseph Health Services
- currentcare can now receive and send continuity of care documents (CCDs) for consented patients
- currentcare can now electronically notify physicians via Direct Messaging when their patients are admitted or discharged from participating hospitals
